Blue Mountains Pride is an alliance of LGBTIQ+ groups in the Blue Mountains under the Pride banner. Larry has done a sterling job in



conceptualising, promoting and enrolling our partner queer social groups in the mountains to this endeavour.

June is Pride month around the world. While Sydney's main celebration is Mardi Gras, it also holds a Pride festival in June. We are seeing more local Pride festivals around Australia.

A Blue Mountains Pride festival will make a great addition to the calendar.

In the Blue Mountains we already have a huge annual LGBTQIA+ weekend on the June (King's Birthday) Weekend. bentART has their annual exhibition that attracts more than 100 art works and hundreds of visitors. Three Sisters Social Group runs the popular Blackheath Disco on the Saturday night and the Annual Costume Ball on the Sunday night. Bush Lemons organise a bushwalk on the weekend (weather permitting). There have been other events over the years including from Pink Mountains and the Trans community.

Blue Mountains Pride has been conceptualised as an umbrella organisation to coordinate and promote this weekend as a Pride festival. It will enable the various Blue Mountains LGBTQIA+ groups to attract more interest in their events.

Each participating organisation will use their resources and networks to promote the weekend along with the events of the whole Festival.

The existing events already constitute an exciting program in the Blue Mountains and serve as the foundation of the Blue Mountains Pride festival. While there is little need to create more events, this will likely happen over the years.

Blue Mountains Pride has the potential to develop as a vibrant LGBTQIA+ presence in the Mountains.
